Every registered IDW 2023 attendee will have access to Whova.

If you have not registered yet, you can still do so until **20th October 2023** at <https://internationaldataweek.org/idw2023/registration/>.

A week prior to the IDW 2023 each registered attendee will receive a link to the email address used during your registration. We kindly ask you to ensure you use the appropriate email address to log in.



Please note that there may be a two-hour delay for your account to activate following your registration, if you register after the event has started or during the event.

To avoid any delays, we recommend that you register as soon as possible.

Once you receive the link, please click “Sign up here” if you don’t have an account yet, and fill in your email and password. Please make sure to use the email you used when registering the event.

You will be taken to the IDW 2023 Whova page, where you can add your information. You will have the option to opt out of being visible on the platform. This will exclude you from the attendee list, and you will not be able to contact others, or be contacted.

Google Chrome is recommended for best performance

Once you have logged in to Whova, you will see the event's main page as shown on the slide.

Using the menu on the left hand side, you can navigate to the agenda, view sessions and speakers, the participants list, community boards (where you can initiate new discussions with others) and messages sent to you by other attendees and organisers.
